

INTERNAL EXAMINATIONS

REGULATIONS

1. Full school uniform must be worn at all times.
2. Be on time for all your examinations. If you are late, your work might not be accepted.
3. Do not become involved in any unfair or dishonest practice during the examinations. If you do, your exam will be nullified.
4. If you cheat, or break the rules in any way, you could be disqualified from all your subjects.
5. Only take into the examination room the materials and equipment which are allowed.
6. No mobile phones, ipods, apple watches etc or any electronic equipment allowed into the examination room. Any pencil cases must be see-through.
7. Do not use correcting fluid or highlighters.
8. Do not talk or try to communicate with or disturb other candidates once the examination has started.
9. Do not borrow anything from another candidate during the examination.
10. Listen to the invigilator and follow their instructions at all times.
11. Tell the invigilator at once: if you think you have not been given the correct question paper or if the question paper is incomplete or badly printed.
12. Read carefully and follow the instructions printed on the question paper.
13. Fill in all the details at the front of the question paper. (Name, class, teacher etc.)
14. Put up your hand during the examination if:
 - You have a problem and are in doubt about what you should do;
 - You do not feel well;
 - You need more paper.
15. You must not ask for, and will not be given, any explanation of the questions.
16. Do not leave the examination room until told to do so by the invigilator.
